

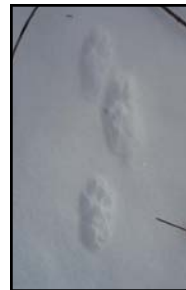


## Winter 2010 Animal Tracking Series At Dyken Pond Environmental Education Center
